NCRI ANNOUNCEMENT FOR RESEARCH PROJECTS

NCRI is proposes small grant of ₹ 40,000/- to the Faculty/ Research Scholars to study the Rural Health, Rural Education, Rural Communication, Rural Governance, Rural Entrepreneurship and any other Government of India flagship programs like Swachha Bharath and Skill Development focused on Rural Concerns. The project is for 2 months, total grant is ₹ 40,000/-. It is released on submission of 40 page report along with photos and day wise Rural Engagement Diary for the one month in field. The study will be published as a monograph by NCRI at NCRI cost. The last date for submission of project proposal is exte4nded up to **28th March 2018**.

Eligibility: Faculty from University/Colleges who have participated in the NCRI FDPs/NIT/IIT department and Research Scholars (those who have completed Ph. D and those who have submitted Ph. D) and interested to work on Rural Concerns, and ready to stay one month in a village.
